

STATE OF TEXAS, COUNTY OF TERRY
ORDER AUTHORIZING INDEPEDENCE DAY FIREWORK SALES

WHEREAS, THE Commissioners Court of Terry County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202(h)(1), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of Independence Day; and


WHEREAS, on the 8th of June 2020, the Commissioners Court of Terry County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Terry County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the Independence Day period beginning of June 24th 2020 and ending at midnight July 4th 2020.

Subject to the following restrictions:

- A. A person may not sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified as "skyrockets with stick" under 49 C.F.R. part. 173.100(r)(2) (10-1-86) edition) or "missiles with fins" in any areas of Terry County.
- B. This Order does not prohibit "permissible fireworks" as authorized in Occupations Code Section 2154.003(a).
- C. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a prohibition established by this Order. An offense under this order is a Class C. Misdemeanor.
