ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING

Whereas, The Commissioners Court finds that circumstances present in all or part on the unincorporated area of the county create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning:

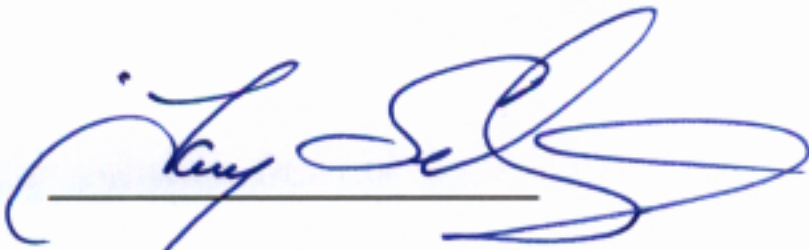
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Commissioners Court of Terry County that all outdoor burning is prohibited in the unincorporated areas of the county for 90 days from the date of adoption of this Order, unless the restrictions are terminated earlier base on a determination made by: (1) the Texas Forest Service that drought conditions no longer exist: or (2) the Commissioners Court base on a determination that the circumstances that required the Order no longer exist.

This Order is adopted pursuant to Local Government Code 352.081, and other applicable statues. This Order does not prohibit outdoor burning activities related to Environment Quality for: (1) firefighters training: (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations: (3) Planting or harvesting of agriculture crops: or (4) burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Natural Resources Code 153.48 and meet the standards of Natural Resources Code 153.047.

In accordance with Local Government Code 352.081 (h), a violation of the order is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
